



Dr. Abdul Aziz Badla

Badla graduated from the Aleppo University-Syria with a bachelor degree in medicine (MBBCH) in 1989 with honors.

He earned a masters degree in Ophthalmology in 1993 from the Ministry of Health-Syria. Badla travelled to Saudi Arabia and earned the clinical fellowship in vitreoretinal surgery from El-Maghraby Eye Hospital (Jeddah) in 1995.

He passed the basic science assessment in ophthalmology including optic and refraction in 1999 and the clinical assessment in ophthalmology in 2003 from the ICO (International Council of Ophthalmology).

Badla is the second secretary of the Syrian Ophthalmological Society . He is the chairman of the Eye Consulting Center in Damascus.
