



## **Dr. Hassan El Dhibi**

Dhibi is currently working at the King Khaled Eye Specialist Hospital (KKESH) as the chief of the Uveitis Division and a member of the Vitreoretinal Diseases and Surgery Division. He joined KKESH in December 1999 and was awarded the first KKESH Physician of the Year in 2007. He is also a clinical assistant professor in the College of Medicine , King Saud University (KSU).

Dhibi completed his Bachelor degree in Medicine and Surgery at KSU in 1992. He then continued his residency fellowship program at the KSU-KKESH. He completed his fellowship training program in ophthalmology in November 1999 and he was awarded with the recognition of outstanding performance during his training.

He actively participates in the training of residents/fellows and supervises the thesis of fourth year residents. He became an examiner for the KSU-KKESH Residency Program and for the Saudi Ophthalmology Board, member of faculty and a lecturer at for undergraduates at Gizan Medical College.

Dhibi's major interest is Clinical research in uveitis and diabetic retinopathy. He was involved in several major research projects and has given over 40 presentations in different meetings. He has served as the author of more than 20 scientific publications.
